From the Knight's Marshal



From the Exchequer

- I got the Herald's signature on the new signature card for the bank. It will actually be changed from "Herald" to "MoA&S".
- The Barony still needs to come up with a "Statement of Refund Policy", and we need to get it into the Baronial Charter as quickly as possible. I have one example to show tonight from Adriana, and then see if there are others. Also need to find out what everyone thinks of this one. ***During the meeting it was discussed and the exact wording was finalized. Chronieler will now place into the Newsletter as well as posting it to the Seadogs List.***
- We will not be getting the P.O. Box for the Exchequer as it would be more of a pain than it is worth.
- There are now forms to be dealt with from this point forward in regards to requesting an advancement of funds, reimbursements, and proposed event budgets (includes expected income and expected expenses). If not used, no advancements or refunds will be handed out. Jonathas will be placing these onto the DC website for downloading and/or printing off.
- There are new Quarterly Report forms to be used right away, and I will be receiving those from Gwen (Regional Exchequer) soon.
- I was unable to attend Unevent and will be meeting up with Gwen as soon as possible with the other area Exchequers to get all of the necessary pass downs. I will have more on this at January's meeting.
- I am trying to get in contact with the Lochmere Exchequer in regards to 12th Night.
- I completed the Exchequer Class at Holiday Faire.
- I received Alienor's receipt for the rapier blade the Barony agreed to purchase.
- I NEED budget for February Event and Challenge.
- Absolutely NO funds will be reimbursed without a receipt in hand.
- We have just under \$5,000 in our account after including the funds turned in from Baroness Amalia at the meeting, for 12th Night.

Officers' Meetings

An officers' meeting was held December 2nd.

The schedule was established for the officers' meetings for the next year. Meetings will be held once each quarter, at 7:30, at various officers' houses:

Loaner gear was discussed at the business meeting. Those who have agreed to donate materials for loaner gear need to turn them in to Evan.

Challenge

Marcia sent an update on Challenge to the e-mail list. The contract is written, not yet signed, but she is meeting with Bozhana on Thursday and should have the contract signed then..

Challenge of the Heart will be held on April 22nd, King's Landing.

The event flier should go out this week, and an event planning meeting will be held, possibly December 17.

12th Night

For merchants at 12th Night, there are 2 10x10 areas & 1 table left. Several merchants have signed up to be at the event. The Sweet Shop, which sells goodies to benefit the royal travel fund, will be there, as will the Spanish Peacock.

There is a royalty room, as well as space set up for two vigils (a Pelican and a Laurel). The vigil sites will be marked off by sheet walls, so will not be as elaborate as was hoped, due to space concerns.

There is also a Herald's table, but time will be limited, as the space will be shared with last year's lost & found.

Unclaimed items from last year may go into the silent auction, if that idea is approved by last year's autocrat.

Reservations are coming to Amalia, as well as to Bozhana and Jynette, in large numbers; it's highly recommended that those who wish to attend pay NOW.

The layout for the hall is posted on the website. Note that Molly will arrange the tables in the A&S hall; they're not in any particular order at the moment.

The autocrat and head cook will be comped for the event, but we need to see about the prince & princess, and king & queen. Bozhana will check past Clyffe Notes to see if this has already been decided, as it has been discussed previously. If so, we'll keep that decision.

Hank motioned for online vote on the issue, Mathias seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous in favor of conducting this vote online after Bozhana has researched it in past Clyffe Notes.

new business

Birthday 2006

A site has been found for Baronial Birthday: the Izaak Walton League in Waldorf.

Site Details:

- Site cost: \$350 for the room, \$100 for the kitchen, plus a \$250 deposit (which we get back if we clean up after ourselves).
- If we need more space and want to rent a second room, it's another \$300.
- Security deposit is needed when we sign the contract, balance is paid the Thursday before the event, when we're given the key to set up Friday.
- Website advertises a non-profit organization discount; the person we talked to will check into that on Friday.
- Kitchen has 6 burners, 2 smallish ovens, a blender, a microwave, and an ice machine. Also has a serving window. Large prep island/cutting surface in the center, but not much counter space at the edges.
- Wet site, as long as no one under 21 is drinking. No permit needed since we're not selling alcohol.

- Candles on tables are allowed.
- Merchants are allowed.
- Fighting, fencing & archery are ok.
- Lots of outdoor space, plenty for archery, heavy fighting, and fencing. (There's a point past which we can't go because it will be hunting season, but there's lots of space even within those boundaries.)
- Fighting, fencing, and archery would all be close to the building. Parking lot is also convenient to fighting & fencing (less to archery but still not bad) & people wouldn't have too far to lug their gear.
- They have tables and chairs. Tables are on wheels.
- Pavillion with 6 picnic tables (roof but no walls, tarps or canvas could be hung if weather got nasty). Could work for troll, or for classes if the weather's nice.
- Person we talked to seemed enthusiastic, thought the SCA sounded neat.
- They already have us penciled in, and will call us if another group wants to reserve the site before we've paid the deposit & signed the contract.
- Plenty of parking (gravel parking lot) with overflow parking onto a grassy area (weather permitting). No parking in front of the building, which is where we'd have the list fields anyway.

Adriana motioned for the Barony to approve this as the Birthday site. Matthew of Summerdale seconded the motion, and it was passed unanimously. Birthday will be held on Nov 11, 2006 at the Izaak Walton League.

Upcoming Events & Activities:

Sewing day is this coming Sunday at Mathilde's house.

Scribes' Day is December 10, 10-6. There are no formal reservations, but Tristan wants a head count.

Currently, Amalia and Muirghen are planning to attend. Adriana had been going to the Scribes' Day, but is going to the Female Fighters' Symposium in Aethelmearc instead. She will try to videotape classes for other female fighters in the barony.

Officers' Reports

Seneschal

Bozhana would like a deputy, as meetings fall on the 1st of the month, which is busy time. Rose has had family issues and has been unable to

help.. Things are going well with the office in general. Bozhana hasn't received any information from Unevent yet.

Exchequer

Serena has Muirghen's signature on the signature card for the bank, but his past office (herald) is listed. As he is still an officer, he can still sign, but the card needs to be changed. Serena motioned to do that if bank will let us simply change the title, and Adriana seconded. The barony voted unanimously in favor of this motion.

The Barony needs a refund policy. Serena received one suggestion (from Adriana). It reads:

If a person has preregistered and paid for a Dun Carraig event but is unable to attend, he or she may request a refund from the barony. The barony may, at its discretion, issue a full or partial refund. Such decisions will be made by the barony on a case-by-case basis. When determining whether or not to issue a refund, the barony will take into account the following:
-Did the event make a profit? (No refunds will be issued for an event that did not turn a profit, nor will refunds be issued that cause the barony to take a loss for any event.)
-What is the nature of the situation that caused a refund request? (In general, a refund will only be considered when circumstances beyond a person's control prevent his or her attending the event or feast.)

Muirghen pointed out that, in the past, we have stipulated that refunds had to be requested before the start of the event, unless there were extenuating circumstances, such as extreme bad weather.

There was also a question as far as the use of the term "the barony." (Would entire barony vote on it, or autocrat & exchequer, exchequer & seneschal?) Baron recommends vote of autocrat, exchequer, and seneschal. (If autocrat is senseschal or exchequer, what do we do?)

It was pointed out that some groups have set cut-offs for refunds, allowing refunds before food is purchased, when seats can still be resold, etc.

A break was taken at the end of the meeting, and the wording of the policy was adjusted by the exchequer and a few others, to be presented to the barony again. (While they were doing that, the rest of the barony was eating the cake provided by our wonderful new MOM.)

The new wording is:

If a person has pre-registered and paid for a Dun Carraig event but is unable to attend, he or she may request a refund from the barony prior to the start of the event. The barony may, at its discretion, issue a full or partial refund. Such decisions will be made (by a financial committee consisting of an odd number of the following: the exchequer, the seneschal, and the event autocrat) on a case-by-case basis. When determining whether or not to issue a refund, this financial committee will take into account the following:

-Did the event make a profit? (No refunds will be issued for an event that did not turn a profit, nor will refunds be issued that cause the barony to take a loss for any event.)

-What is the nature of the situation that caused a refund request? (In general, a refund will only be considered when circumstances beyond a person's control prevent his or her attending the event or feast.)

Jonathas motioned to accept wording to be voted on for charter. The vote is unanimous, in favor of the motion. Because of Kingdom direction, this policy will go into effect for 12th Night. (As per the baronial charter, kingdom policy or directives supersede our charter, which calls for two months of discussion first.)

Serena has decided not to get a PO box for the Exchequer's office, as there is no central location that would be accessible to whomever might hold the office next.

Serena wants to remind the barony that no advances of money will be given unless the proper forms are filled out. Proposed budgets also need to be submitted by the autocrat before any money is spent on an event. Serena has these forms and can give them to anyone who needs them, and they will also be posted on the website.

Serena will also be receiving new quarterly report forms from the regional exchequer.

She couldn't attend Unevent, but regional exchequer will meet with her to discuss any changes brought up there.

She is also working on getting in touch with Lochmere's exchequer for 12th Night.

She received a receipt for the new rapier gear that was purchased.

She still needs a budget for A Day in the Middle East and Challenge.

There will absolutely under no circumstances be any money given out

specifics, chat with an archery marshal.

Chronicler

As of this meeting, Lylie is stepping down as chronicler, and the office will be taken over by Adriana, her deputy. It was discussed at the officers' meeting whether there would be any required period for Adriana to serve as deputy, and there is not.

Chirurgion

Minna is resubmitting her apprentice chirurgion paperwork, which has not been received by the Kingdom Chirurgion. Matthew still needs to submit his paperwork. Adriana's has been submitted, and she will check to see if it was received.

Also, it was mentioned that, technically, we can't refer to Minna as chirurgion because she is not one yet. Technically, the barony does not have one. Minna is looking at events at which she can apprentice, and she should be done by next year.

*(Chronicler's Note: Even though we technically do not have a Chirurgion, any mention of Minna's progress toward becoming a Chirurgion, other barony members' progress on that, or other Chirurgion-related info will still be referred to under the **Chirurgion's report** in the minutes, as "Person Who Has Been Approved by the Barony to Take Over the Office, Has Her Mundane Certs But Still Needs to Complete her Apprenticeship" is entirely too long a heading.)*

MOM

Kier has contacted Kingdom about youth programs. The program for December petered out, but she will try to get it set up for Christmas break when kids are off school.

Kier will set up a Kid's Corner at 12th Night, A Day in the Middle East, and Challenge.

She had also wanted to organize for youth fight practice at Storvik, but one was postponed. She will look at doing this during winter break, since kids go to bed early, have school, etc.

Kier is getting ready for 12th Night, and the ME event, and she has gotten

without a receipt submitted to Serena. The barony has had issues with this in the past..

We now have \$4900. This may be a record. (The number will go up, then drop rapidly as we pay for 12th Night.)

B&B

Because Birthday didn't happen, the B&B need to choose marshalled champions. There's no upcoming event at which to hold a tourney, either ours or a neighbor's. The B&B ask everyone who wishes to be considered for champion as rapier, heavy, or archery to write them a letter explaining they would like to be champion and how they think they could serve the barony in this capacity. The B&B would rather have an individual for each championship, rather than having the same person hold multiple championships. Champions are expected to attend at least one kingdom level event to represent DC in their respective marshalled activity. Send the letter in at least two weeks prior to February's event (with an informal heads-up as soon as possible). The decision will be announced at the February event.

Quartermaster

If you have barony stuff, please give Mathias a specific date to come over. Saying "come over any time" isn't always effective, as "any time" never seems to happen.

Herald

Muirghen is stepping down at 12th Night, and Mathias is stepping up. He needs to confirm that he has his warrant in. Muirghen will take care of the report for the last quarter and will retain warrant as herald, just won't be baronial herald. He has a couple people working on names/devices that he's assisting. Now's a good time to submit heraldry because things are quiet, but it still takes a long time to get things registered, names faster than devices. (Devices have a mandatory three-month comment period.)

Knight Marshal

We need marshals. We need marshals. Oh, and also...we need marshals. If you fight, please consider becoming one.

There have been some changes to archery rules. If you're interested in the

info on games, and should be all set for Challenge. (She needs to e-mail Jynette to confirm 12th Night info.)

Please donate crafty stuff or other odds & ends for the youth. Kier especially needs paints, crayons, and markers. (Bo & Muirghen offered to donate.) She's also watching "free stuff" e-mail lists to get supplies for the youth.


