



### Directions:

#### From Patuxent River Naval Air Station:

North on Route 235 - 6 miles. Turn Left on Airport Road (at Outback Steak House). Proceed ½ mile on Airport Road. SMHEC is located on the left across from the SMC Airport Runway. SMHEC 44219 Airport Road California, MD 20619

#### From Solomons:

Follow Route 4 across the Bridge into St. Mary's County. Proceed approximately 4 miles to the intersection of Rt. 4 and Rt. 235. Turn Right (North) on Route 235 At the 2nd light, turn left onto Airport Road (at the Outback Steak House) and proceed ½ mile. Center is on the left.

Take Route 5 to Route 235 (approximately 22 miles). Follow Route 235 approximately 13 miles to Wildewood Shopping Center (Airport Road). Turn right on Airport Road; Center is ½ mile up the hill on the left.

## January Business Meeting

### Minutes

January 8, 2008

### Middle Eastern

Lore passed out a task list. (Names in bold are confirmed volunteers; those not in bold are suggestions.)

Lore would like to do another sweatshop for fabric banners—date TBA.

A couple signs need repair—Mathias will work on those.

Children's activities are planned. Because the event is after the background check deadline, we need to find out how that will affect kids' activities.

Lore has asked the queen if she needed retainers, and if she wanted to sponsor a contest.

## Kingdom Event Bids

Because there are a large number of kingdom events for which no bids have been put in, the barony discussed the possibility of running a kingdom event.

The general consensus was in favor of hosting a kingdom event. We still need someone to step up and decide what sort of kingdom event they're interested in autocratting & put together a proposal for the barony. (If you want it to happen, you have to run it.)

Before an event bid can go through on the kingdom level, local officers have to sign off on it.

## Future Happenings

Kaolin is going to Camp Brown to pursue using that as a site. Possible future site of Challenge or kingdom-level events. The site has been prohibitively expensive in the past, but management has changed, so we don't know what will happen price-wise.

**Media Relations** – Wednesday the 9th, we'll have a reporter & possibly a photographer at practice. Fighters are encouraged to wear their nice stuff. Everyone is encouraged to come, work on projects, and hang out. Because we want to give the best possible showing, anyone who might talk to the reporter should read the SCA's media policy before practice.

## Opening the Seadogs List

It has been suggested again that the Seadogs list be opened up again. (Membership on the list would be open to anyone, regardless of location. They would still have to ask to join the list and be approved by Serena, but anyone who's a real person, and not a spammer, would be added to the list.)

The possibility of opening the list was discussed. A related discussion also considered whether to keep two separate lists or get down to one. (The DC-News list was originally added so that people not part of the barony could keep up with baronial goings-on, but an open list might make that unnecessary. However, some people also want to receive announcements and news only.)

The barony voted and unanimously approved the motion to open the Seadogs list to anyone who wants to join. II-0

It was noted that there still has to be the opportunity to restrict someone's access or posting if there are flames, harassment, etc. (Seneschal requests that if anyone sees that going on, contact him.)

The barony will consider combining the two lists, if we can find a way to do so that is not cumbersome and that will continue to allow people to have control over the volume/type of email they receive. Serena will look into options on that. These include using the Announcement feature for information that would currently be posted on the news list, such as practices, A&S nights, etc.

## **Exchequer**

Serena provided the following report:

My 4<sup>th</sup> quarter report is due prior to January 31<sup>st</sup>. The Doomsday (end of year) report is also due prior to January 31<sup>st</sup>. I just received the bank statement today so the reports will now be finalized.

A reminder that recently I uploaded some new forms to our Baronial website. Please go there and view which forms they are. Some changes are not noticeable at first, so if you have any of those forms from a date prior to the date on our website, please delete those forms from your records and use only these new forms.

I reviewed with Minna (Mindy) about a question the financial committee had about something on one

of the Birthday receipts, and it was determined that those items would not be reimbursed, per Minna (Mindy).

I'm still dealing with the I check for Birthday that was returned for their account being closed.

Closed out cash advance for Halloween Demo candy with Kaolin (Jen).

A Financial committee meeting was held and the ADITME budget was put together, voted on, and approved.

Per the Exchequer's meeting at Unevent, I am working with our bank to change the name of our account. Instead of being labeled "Barony of Dun Carraig, SCA, Inc." it must now read "SCA, Inc. Barony of Dun Carraig". If they won't change the name without fees involved for new checks, Regional is to be contacted to see if we have to go ahead and purchase new checks or if we have permission to use up the current ones first.

I'm finalizing the financial policy changes, as it must go in with the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter and doomsday reports.

I'm still working with those who have funds approved for them for spending but that haven't been spent yet. Theron (Tom) regarding the baronial tent repair (\$20 approved); & Mathias (Jim) regarding general Quartermaster supplies for loaner gear and kitchen supplies (\$75 approved). Mathias was holding out on purchasing these supplies until the Baronial Shed had been put together and is ready to use, so the correct supplies can be purchased according to needs.

Her Excellency requested that all barony members who can come to the "town hall" business meeting in February. Rather than a set agenda, this will be a chance for the populace to ask questions, offer suggestions, criticism, or praise to the baronage and seneschal.



## **Growing Herbs - the Basics**

Perhaps you'd like to use fresh herbs in your cooking or you enjoyed the fragrance of the herbs as you brushed past them in a museum garden. Whatever the reason, the idea has taken root and you're ready to start. If you knew where to start.

First consider the space you have available for the garden. How much sunlight does it receive? Does it get direct sun all day, part of the day or is it in shade? Most herbs prefer full sun, needing at least 4-6 hours of direct sun a day, although there are a few that will tolerate shade.

What type of soil is in the garden - clay and silt, sand or loam? Clay and silt soils have very small particles and slick and sticky when wet. They hold water well, sometimes too well, but water runs off quickly when the surface is dry. Sandy soil contain large particles and does not compact well when squeezed in your fist. This soil type is usually light colored and does not retain water well. Loam is a combination of the first two soil types and organic matter. Moist loam will form a ball when squeezed in your fist and the ball crumbles when poked. It absorbs and holds water well. Most soils can be amended by the addition of organic matter to make it more productive and balance the sand/clay ratios.

Does water stand in the space you've selected or does it stream through the area after a heavy rain? If so, look for another area. Your plants won't appreciate being drowned or swept away. Consider raised beds to improve drainage.

Do a little research on the herbs you would like to grow. Some plants take more water than others and some will tolerate shade better. Group your herbs by their light, water and soil needs. Some don't take well to heat and need to be started early in the season. Most herbs can be sown directly in the garden, while others will be most successful if bought as seedlings or cuttings and transplanted into the garden.

If you buy a packet of seeds, be sure the seeds are fresh. Results will be much better with seeds that haven't been on the shelf for years. Check the packet for the date. Seedlings should be from a nearby nursery or gardening department. The microclimate from a nearby source will more closely match that of your garden than one located across town. Look for healthy plants with a good color. Tall, spindly

plants are not better than short, bushy plants.

Don't crowd your plants. The seed packet or information marker with your seedling will list the space the plant needs. Heed their advice and give your herb room to grow.

Herbs, like all plants, like fertilizer. The herbs will grow bigger and greener if fertilized. Fertilized herbs tend to have less essential oils than their unfertilized counterparts. Less essential oil equals less flavor and aroma. The choice is up to the gardener.

Mulch your herb beds with 1-3 inches of a hardwood mulch or hardwood and sawdust mix. Mulch conserves water and cuts down on weeds. It also helps control the spread of invasive herbs, such as mint. The time you spend in mulching will be repaid in the time you don't have to spend in watering and weeding.

Herbs are generally quite hardy and resistant to insects and diseases. If you plan to use your herbs in cooking, do not use synthetic pesticides on them. Insecticidal soap or horticultural oil can control severe outbreaks of aphids and mites. Planting a variety of herbs generally helps attract helpful insects to keep the harmful ones in check.

If you have questions or problems, many resources are available. Your local county extension service offers many types of assistance, from lists of the best varieties of each herb for the area to free or low cost soil tests to free classes. Many of the gardening clubs offer help to gardeners. You might ask a member of your local herbalist guild.
