## Chronicler's Choice

*This section is intended to highlight interesting, copyright-expired books that are available for free download.*

Not a book this time, but a virtual tour. The Cathedral of Santa Maria Mediavilla in Teruel, Spain, is called the Sistine Chapel of Mudéjar art, for an elaborate wooden ceiling painted in the 13th or 14th century. It includes complex geometric designs, mythical animals, floral designs, and a wide variety of secular and religious human figures doing everything from carpentry & painting to jousting & partying. The ceiling was recently restored, and the paintings are sharp and bright. The cathedral is a UNESCO world heritage site. *(Thanks to Mistress Beatriz Aluarez for bringing the paintings to my attention during her clothing workshop.)*

This website (below) gives a very detailed tour of the ceiling. The text is in Spanish. "Pagina siguiente" at the bottom right takes you to the next page. Keep clicking "Pagina siguiente" - There are a lot of pages, and the most interesting ones are in the "tabicas" section near the end of the tour. Here is the start of the ceiling tour:




