

The <u>Members of Cavalry</u> are invited to form their own tournament companies (consisting of 1 rider, 1 herald, 1 archer, & 2 armored combatants) under the arms of their choice and/or creation to compete in the Grand Tournament on Saturday. The tournament will begin with an <u>Archery Tournament</u>, followed by an <u>Armored Melee</u>, then completed by the <u>Cavalry Challenge Course</u>. The finale of the tournament will be a singles <u>Jousting Tournament</u> for all those authorized.



All activities will happen where the attendees can watch and enjoy the prowess of the competitors from the comfort of the <u>Ladies'</u> <u>Gallery</u> or their personal pavilions. Spectators will be judging to determine Best Procession, Best Heraldic Display, and Best Herald of the Day. In addition to the Grand Tournament on Saturday, there will be various A&S Competitions Children's Activities, including a hobby horse race at the completion of the armored melee!
