

Greetings Atlantia,



The past few weeks have brought many disturbing issues to light, on top of a situation that is already stressful and challenging. Many of you may be aware that, in some kingdoms, expressions of intolerance and hate have appeared in associated Kingdom forums, offices, or in connection with an individual's SCA persona or profile. We are grateful and appreciative that Atlantia has not exhibited such abject disrespect for others, but the examples displayed in other kingdoms give Us great concern.

We have always considered Atlantia to be an extraordinary kingdom, where tolerance, acceptance and inclusion are the standard, rather than the exception. Atlantia must continue to hold fast to the best ideals of the human condition: nobility, compassion, and honor. Our actions and words are important; they are the facets by which each of us is measured. We are a group, a kingdom, a society, but at the end of the day, we are people. As individuals, we are responsible for what we say, what we do, and how we say and do it. No one else can be blamed or assigned for our choices; accountability begins and ends with us.

As Monarchs, We are accountable to you; We took an oath to serve Atlantia, and to act in its' best interests. The interests of Atlantia are not best served by tolerating or fostering an atmosphere of hostility, discrimination, or bias by any of Our people, or in Our forums and social media. While We respect that each person is entitled to their own unique viewpoint, expressing a viewpoint that promotes hatred, bullying, or intolerance of others, will not be accepted. Should these types of communications be publicized by an Atlantian citizen in any SCA-related forum, social media, or in conjunction or association with an SCA name, office, or profile, We will act in the swiftest and most severe manner available to Us as Monarchs to resolve the issue.

So, Atlantia, be thoughtful and mindful before you communicate. If you have concerns about whether your words are harmful, talk to people whose judgment you trust before releasing that communication. Ultimately, however, you will be the one held accountable for what you express. We trust and have confidence that We will never be called upon to take such punitive actions. Please, do not break that trust.

Business Meeting Minutes

The July business meeting will be held via Zoom at 7PM on July 7.

If you did not receive an email with the meeting link, contact one of the Baronial officers listed on the last page.

There was a business meeting via Zoom on June 2, but your Chronicler forgot to attend (*mea culpa*). Her Excellency Baroness Ceridwen graciously provided these notes from the meeting.

1. Harold and I told the Barony about the meeting that their Majesties had had with the baronage on zoom. One of the questions their Majesties asked was even if different parts of the kingdom opened up, and people could have events, did we as baronage think people would go to events in different states? We said that we as baronage would suggest that people be very careful in their decision making whether to go to events or not, because it is a huge risk even though we miss each other.
2. We discussed crown tournament. The policy the kingdom has been working under is they will wait until 30 days after the kingdom "Opens", which is when all states in the kingdom open to gatherings of 500 or more.
3. The kingdom is hoping and working towards being able to have War of the Wings in October. They are currently not spending any money that could not be refunded if the event could not be held.
4. Their Majesties want people to keep sending award recommendations. However, TRMs told us that they had no intention of holding virtual courts because being called into court, especially for an award of arms, is a defining moment in someone's SCA journey, and that experience is not possible with a virtual court.
5. Baronial Birthday- planning on hold for now. Baroness Lore was looking into using Richard And Mary's Church as a site, but since they have not been in session she has not been able to talk to anyone as of yet.
6. Fighter practice-still canceled for now
7. I, (Ceridwen), asked for a poll to go up with the idea of having a Baronial zoom happy hour/share projects/hang out. I wanted to know if people were interested I'm having a place biweekly or once a month where they could just come together and hang out. (Chris put the poll up on Facebook that night)
