





## October Business Meeting Minutes

October 9, 2007

#### Birthday

Minna still needs to talk to some merchants.

Khadir will be talking to Mathilde regarding artisan's row.

The program will include a list of meanings for all the runes that will be used as site tokens.

Mathias is now the MIC for Birthday.

We have two classes scheduled: Viking etiquette & beadcraft

Someone is teaching a Viking garb class @ Mathilde's.

Event ends at 10.

The autocrat has requested a sign cautioning people to drive slowly on the gravel entry road. (Cops do speed trapping.) Adriana will make the sign.

We have a gorgeous Viking sword as the heavy tourney prize (if the field is worthy—for example, if half a dozen people fight, another prize will be given). This sword was given to Khadir to hold onto and ensure that it goes to a worthy individual.

If you are on a list, please please please plug Birthday!!

Set-Up is Friday at 4:00 PM. Anyone who can make it is encouraged to help.

#### Demos

Kaolin would like to thank everyone for their help at Blessing of the Fleet. A few people seemed interested, but she has received no e-mails yet.

The application has been submitted for Halloween in the garden on the 27th. II-4. She asked about a clearing so that we could do fighting. They're considering it, but cannot promise anything.

The financial committee approved \$100 for candy to pass out to the children at Halloween in the Garden. (Erwin, Theron, Bobbi, Matthias, Adriana in attendance. Unanimous in favor.)

#### Shed

The shed has been ordered and is in We have to show them our tax free card & they have a form to fill out, and then it's all ours.

The cost is \$498. The shed is available & in stock, and is on hold for two days for us. We're also getting an \$84 metal foundation kit, that plywood foundation gets added to.

Serena needs to contact Debbie See (the admin manager for customer service), to confirm our two-signature check.

The plan is to have everything go into shed after Birthday. Therefore, it was decided at the business meeting (after confirming that most people present could attend) that the barony meeting would be rescheduled to November  $3^{rd}$  at Erwin's at II AM

#### Middle Eastern

The event is scheduled March 29<sup>th</sup>—later than the autocrat wanted, but we're kind of stuck based on available dates for the church, other scheduled events, etc.

Asim (from NC) will be teaching three classes.

Middle Eastern does conflict with Defending the Gate. Lore spoke with their autocrat and seneschal and it's ok to conflict.

The exchequer has pointed out that we need the contract ASAP because money has been handed in. (This puts us in violation of both baronial and kingdom financial policy until it's resolved.)

In terms of A&S at Birthdya, there will be both brewing & boasting contests—to fit the Viking theme. Artisans' Row will also take place.

#### Exchequer

I need a copy of the contract for Birthday signed by everyone. I also need a copy of the contract for ADITME signed by everyone.

My 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter report is due by end of October.

Financial Committee voted and approved a site deposit of \$200 for ADITME '08. Check written and handed over to Theron (Tom) to get to Lore.

Financial Committee voted and approved \$100 advance to Kaolin (Jen) for candy for the demo at Ann Marie Gardens. Check written and handed over to Kaolin.

Financial Committee voted and approved \$44.8I reimbursement to Theron (Tom) for Pennsic sink and faucet. Check written and handed over to Theron.

Financial Committee voted and approved \$46.05 reimbursement to Serena (Bobbi) for Exchequer Expenses. Check written and handed over to Serena.

I'm still working with those who have funds approved for them for spending but that haven't been spent yet. Theron (Tom) regarding the baronial tent repair (\$20 approved); & Mathias (Jim) regarding general Quartermaster supplies for loaner gear and kitchen supplies (\$75 approved). Mathias is holding out on purchasing these supplies until the Baronial Shed has been put together and is ready to use, so the correct supplies can be purchased according to needs.

#### Seneschal

The barony will hold a town forum style meeting, which is intended to give the populace the opportunity to bring any questions, problems, or concerns before the officers. This will happen between Birthday & Middle Eastern, probably at the February meeting.

If anyone has questions or concerns they need the B&B to answer that will require research, they request that you give them a little heads-up so they can come to the meeting prepared.

The barony still needs a Chancellor of Youth. Our previous youth officer was asked to return and agreed; however, when the barony voted on whether to have her resume her position, the votes were not there.
