# March Ousiness Meeting Minutes



Nothing to report but that the event on Saturday (A Day in the Middle East) was a very popular success.



#### Unto the most Gracious Barony of Dun Carraig do we, Gormr Dómarsson and Isolda de **C**rosthwaite, send our heartiest greetings.

We send this missive to tell you of our wish to become your next Baron and Baroness. In the last two and a half years we have seen the people in our land rise from the ashes and become, again, one barony. Though they refuse to take all the credit, we believe a large part of this is due to the dedication of our present Baron and Baroness, and we wish to continue in their footsteps with the same commitment and spirit of enthusiasm. We do not enter into this lightly. We realize that this job is hard work, and that there will be times when we may not feel like giving any more. But we will, because we want this Barony to continue to shine. We realize that this job comes with the responsibility of making important deci– sions for the Barony, and that the choices that we make won't necessarily be liked by everyone. But we also hope that you would know from our previous actions that we would make these decisions to serve you, the populace.

As your Baronage, we would like to see some things continue to progress as they have for the last two years, and we would like to start some new things, too. We'd like to continue the current emphasis on financial responsibility. While we are all in this to have fun, the unfortunate truth is that the mundane world requires that we have money to operate. With this in mind, we want to continue promoting and selling the Spike tattoos, and would like to put into practice other ideas from people in the barony. Isolda has proposed selling the oval window stickers/decals with the initials "PW" (Pennsic War) in a calligraphic font. Perhaps we can give this a try and see how well they sell. Financial responsi–

bility also refers to how we plan our events. For instance, we would like to see all Dun Carraig events be as successful as our recent Baronial Birthday and Middle Eastern events were. In order to achieve this, we would suggest that Dun Carraig events become more focused. We would describe A Day in the Middle Eastas "focused," where one type of activity (A&S, fighting or archery, etc.) is the center of the event. Historically, this event has been financially and reputably successful, and it promises to be even more so in the future. A number of successful events in neighboring baronies could also be described as focused: On Target and Night on the Townin Lochmere are both good examples of focused local events that have been consistently successful. We would also like to see the Birthday event become more successful by remodeling it. It seems throughout the kingdom, that birthday events with a particular theme are much more worthwhile to those coming from out of barony. The theme of War of the Roses for our past Birthday, plus the shtick provided by Their Excellencies, made it very memorable. Given the situation of many people at this point in time, it's not hard to imagine more people choosing a themed event over someone else's Birthday event.

We also want to continue working on recruiting. Dun Carraig has recently had a bit of a hard time bringing in new blood...and keeping it. We would both like to work with the Chatelaine to focus our efforts at finding and retaining new members. We want to talk to the new members we do have and find out what about the SCA, and Dun Carraig in particular, caught their eye; and what has kept and will keep them coming back. We both feel that this will be an important endeavor as the barony needs to be able to cycle its officers and duties so that no one feels obligated to keep doing what they're doing, and subsequently becomes burned out.

Our intent, were we to be chosen, is to have an open door policy. We believe that successful leaders all have one thing in common: they surround themselves with successful advisors. We realize that in the barony we have a wealth of successful, qualified and experienced advisors. When faced with major decisions, we will consult them, and our door will be open to anyone else who wishes to offer advice or an opinion. Please realize, however, that we cannot please all the people all the time. This means that if we do not follow through on advice that was given to us, please know that we still value your opinion and did consider it. Ultimately, it will still be our decision to make, and our consequences to bear.

Isolda, much like Molly, wishes to continue to promote the Arts and Sciences, while Gormr wants to work to bring a fight– ing culture back to Dun Carraig. He will fight in any event he attends (that includes fighting) and will represent this wonderful barony to the best of his abilities. Each of us fully supports the other in these endeavors as well.

As Baron and Baroness, we feel that everything we do while wearing the "hats" will reflect on you, the people of Dun Carraig. And we want to make this barony a good name for you...something you can be proud of. As always, we would like to see people, new and veteran, to become more involved, and we want to promote a sense of baronial unity. To encourage this, we plan to open our house up for activities (A&S projects, armor workshops, meetings, etc.), and to attend activities that others host, as a way of showing support.

On the surface, our experience in the SCA and Dun Carraig seems little, especially when compared with candidates from the last polling. However, we think that if you look deeper, though we each have been playing for only 5 years, we each have multiple awards on Baronial and Kingdom levels for service. This is what the role of Baron and Baroness will entail. We will be serving you. And if those awards are any indication, so far we have done it well. We ask for the chance to prove that we can serve you properly.

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
