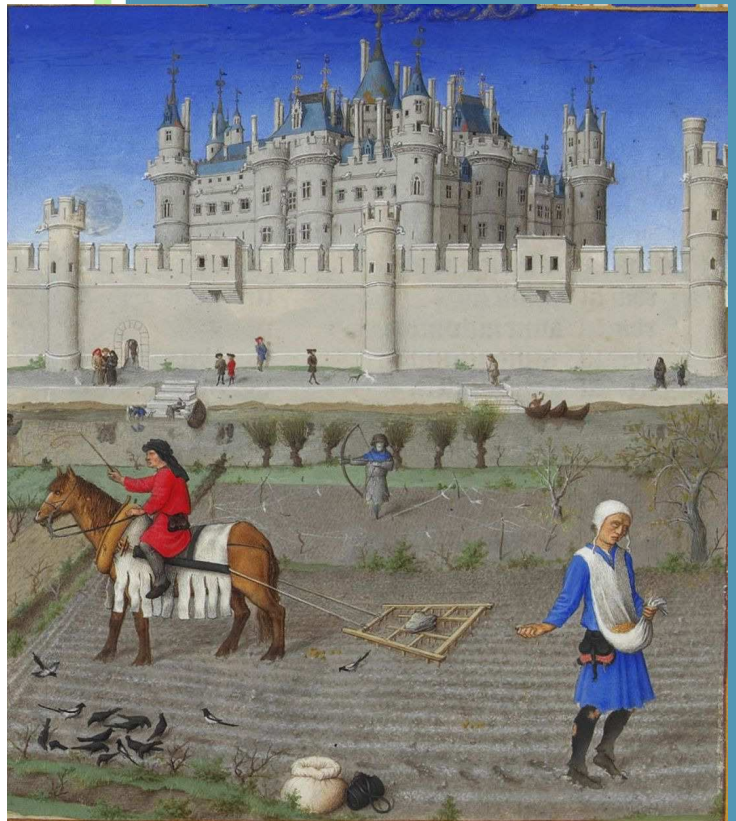

The Anglo-Saxon charms (1909) <http://archive.org/details/anglosaxoncharms00gren>

Sample charm: AGAINST A WITCH'S SPELL

After fasting for a night, eat the root of a radish. On that day the spell will not have power to harm you.

Codex Exoniensis. A collection of Anglo-Saxon poetry, from a manuscript in the library of the dean and chapter of Exeter, with an English translation, notes, and indexes (1842)

This book includes two sections of Anglo-Saxon riddles, with English translations – but no answers.

Sample riddle 23: A creature came walking where men sate, many in assembly, prudent-minded; it had one eye, and two ears, and two feet, twelve hundred heads, a back and belly, and two hands, arms and shoulders, one neck, and two sides. Say what I am call'd.

Old English riddles (1912) <http://archive.org/details/oldenglishriddle00wyat>

The same riddles, untranslated, but with a table of various scholar's solutions to the riddles (riddle 23 above: a one-eyed garlic seller)

The hundred riddles of Symphosius (1912) <http://archive.org/details/hundredriddlesof00symp>

Latin Riddles, with English translations, and answers in the back of the book.

Written 2nd- 4th centuries AD, and known by scholars in England & France in the 7th and 8th centuries.

Sample riddle LIV: My form is small, the crooked dagger's pride,

With treacherous lures, throughout the stream I hide;

I charm to hurt, and then my food to death confide. (answer: fish-hook)

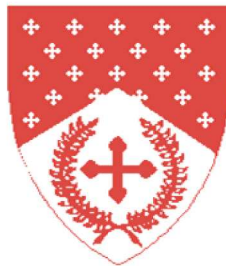

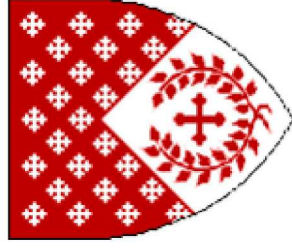
